## VRANA-VRANSKO JEZERO, KAMENJAK, ORNITOLOSKI REZERVAT, MASKOVICA HAN

Lake Vrana is located in the small village Vrana more than 12,000 years. In the beginning, it was only a small pond, but now it is the largest natural lake in Croatia. Even tho it was created over a thousand years ago, it was declared a nature park on September 16, 1999. Lake Vrana is home to more than 20 species of fish and 235 species of birds. There is also an ornithological reserve in the park, which was created in 1983. This reserve is one of the most valuable in Croatia. 13 species of birds live inside the reserve, whose local populations from the lake are important for the survival of the entire species. Čaplja danguba is the symbol of the park and is one of 13 species. Hotel Maškovića Han is located near the lake. It was built in the 17th century by order of Jusaf Mašković. It served as a resort and innkeeper. Maskovica Han, Vransko jezero, and the reserve can be seen from Kamenjak. Kamenjak is located near the highest peak of the park (Štandarac) at a height of about 283 meters above the sea.

## NARODNI MUZEJ

The National Museum was opened in 1832 and is the second oldest museum in Croatia. It contains about 100,000 items. The Archaeological Museum developed from it in 1897, and the Natural History Museum in 1905. In 1948, the Art Gallery was opened. In 1962, the museums were separated into different museums, but in 1962 they were united again. Now the museum has more departments and objects than before.
